

JANUARY 9, 1992

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Regular Council Meeting, Thursday, January 9, 1992, in the Council Chamber in Idaho Falls, Idaho. There were present: Mayor Tom Campbell; Councilmembers Art Chandler, Melvin Erickson, Joe Groberg, Sam Sakaguchi, and Ralph Wood; absent, Councilmember Wes Deist. Also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Dale Storer, City Attorney; and all available Division Directors.

The City Clerk read a summary of the minutes of the last Regular Council Meeting held December 19, 1991. The minutes were approved.

The Mayor expressed his appreciation to the outgoing Councilmembers and thanked them for their years of service and dedication to the City.

The Mayor then invited Councilmembers-elect, Linda Milam, Gary Mills, and Larry Carlson to come forward to the Council table. The Mayor then proceeded to, individually, administer the Oath of Office to the three Councilmembers-elect for a four year term on the Council.
