

**OCTOBER 18, 1990**

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Regular Council Meeting, Thursday, October 18, 1990, in the Council Chamber in Idaho Falls, Idaho. Prior to calling the meeting to order, the Mayor welcomed several scouts who were present in the Council Chamber and called upon one of them, Hoyt Wooley, to come forward and lead all those present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The Mayor then called the meeting to order, and upon roll call, the following were found to be present: Mayor Tom Campbell; Councilmen Ralph Wood, Art Chandler, Mel Erickson, Wes Deist, Joe Groberg, and Sam Sakaguchi. Also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Dale Storer, City Attorney and all available Division Directors.

The City Clerk read a summary of the minutes of the last Regular Council Meeting held October 4, 1990. The minutes were approved by the Mayor and Councilmembers.

Recommendation #4: It is recommended that a request for a Crossing Guard on Higbee directly in front of Longfellow School be denied. It was moved by Councilman Erickson, seconded by Chandler, that the Traffic Safety Committee's recommendation be upheld and the request denied. Recommendation #5: It is recommended that a request to remove the Postal Drop Boxes from the Parking Lot at the Eagle Rock Post Office to the West side of Capital Avenue between E & F Streets with replacement of sidewalk, curb, and gutter at the full expense of the Postal Service be approved. It was moved by Councilman Erickson, seconded by Chandler, that this request be approved. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Wood, Chandler, Erickson, Deist, Groberg, and Sakaguchi; No, none; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Wood, seconded by Chandler, that the meeting adjourn at 7:50 P.M., carried.
