

JULY 5, 1990

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Regular Council Meeting, Thursday, July 5, 1990, in the Council Chamber in Idaho Falls, Idaho. There were present: Mayor Tom Campbell; Councilmen Mel Erickson, Wes Deist, Sam Sakaguchi, Ralph Wood, and Art Chandler; Absent, Councilman Joe Groberg. Also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Dale Storer, City Attorney and all available Division Directors.

The City Clerk read a summary of the minutes of a Special Meeting held June 19, 1990. The minutes were approved.

The Mayor and Councilmembers honored Eagle Scout Billy Wells.

New Police Officers Curtis Bateman, William Ashton, and Kenneth Zaugg were introduced and welcomed to the Police Force.

The Mayor declared open a public hearing, as legally advertised, to consider a request to rezone Lots 1 and 2, Block 30, Capital Hill Addition, and called upon Councilman Chandler to conduct the hearing. At the request of Councilman Chandler, the City Clerk read the following memo:

Attached is a copy of a request to rezone the above-described property. The City Council, on May 10, considered this item and at that time, it was referred back to the Planning Commission for further consideration. The Planning Commission discussed this matter at the June 12 Regular Meeting. At that time, after some discussion, the Planning Commission stated they do not think it is advisable to rezone all four corners of this intersection when there are already existing buildings and uses conforming with the existing zoning.

After some discussion, it was unanimously recommended that the rezoning be denied because of lack of parking and the existing policy to hold the commercial zoning to the alley between Lomax and First Street. This Department concurs with that recommendation and it is now being submitted to the Mayor and City Council for consideration.

The Director of Planning further explained the request and located the subject area on a map on the wall.

Mark Woodland, the requester, appeared briefly to state that it was his understanding, from a previous hearing, that a review was to have been made for consideration of rezoning the entire immediate area and this, apparently, has not been done. During discussion, concerns were addressed that there is not adequate parking available, and the possibility that the accident potential may be compounded in the area if rezoned.

There being no others who wished to speak, it was moved by Councilman Chandler, seconded by Wood, that the Council follow the recommendation of the Planning Commission and deny the request. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Erickson, Deist,

Sakaguchi, Wood, and Chandler; No, none; carried. Councilman Chandler advised Mr. Woodland of the procedure if he wished to further pursue the request.

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Annexation Proceedings were conducted for Stonebrook Addition, Division No. 6. Councilman Chandler asked the City Clerk to read the following memo:

Attached is a copy of the Final Plat, Annexation Agreement, and Annexation Ordinance for Stonebrook Addition, Division No. 6. This is located adjacent to and immediately south of Sunnyside Road and to the southeast of the existing Stonebrook development. This subdivision contains 12 residential lots and one large lot which will be the site of the new Junior High School.

The Planning Commission considered this matter at their May meeting, and at that time, recommended approval of the Plat, Annexation to the City, and initial zoning of RP-A. It is now being submitted to the Mayor and City Council for consideration.

It was moved by Councilman Chandler, seconded by Wood, that the initial zoning of Stonebrook Addition, Division No. 6 be established as RP-A as recommended and that the comprehensive plan be amended to include the area annexed herewith, and that the City Planner be instructed to reflect said annexation and zoning maps located in his office.
