

**MARCH 24, 1988**

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Regular Council Meeting, Thursday, March 24, 1988, in the Council Chamber in Idaho Falls, Idaho. There were present: Mayor Thomas Campbell; Councilmen Sam Sakaguchi, Ralph Wood, Arthur Chandler, Wesley Deist, and Paul Hovey. Absent: Councilmen Melvin Erickson. Also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Dale Storer, City Attorney; and all available Division Directors.

The City Clerk read a summary of the minutes of the last Regular Council Meeting held March 10, 1988. The minutes were approved by the Council.

Mayor Campbell introduced Bob Holm as the newly appointed City Controller.

Item #3 recommended denial of center striping of Hansen Avenue and to leave the parking as is. It was moved by Councilman Chandler, seconded by Wood, that center striping of Hansen Avenue be denied and the parking remain as is. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Chandler, Deist, Hovey, Sakaguchi, and Wood; No, none; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Sakaguchi, seconded by Wood, that the meeting adjourn at 7:445 P.M.; carried.
