

**MAY 27, 1986**

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, met in special public session at the Conference Room at the City Hall, 308 "C" Street, in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, at 7:30 A.M., on May 27, 1986. The roll was called and the following found to be present: Mayor Thomas V. Campbell; Councilmen Arthur Chandler, Jr., Wesley W. Deist, Melvin L. Erickson, Paul L. Hovey, Sam Sakaguchi, and Ralph Wood. There were also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Dale W. Storer, City Attorney; G. S. Harrison, Manager Electric Light Division; S. Craig Lords, Municipal Services Director. Absent, none.

After the meeting had been called to order, the roll called with the above result, the City Clerk presented the call of the special meeting by the Mayor of at least one-half (1/2) plus one (1) of the members of the full Council, which call was ordered recorded in the minutes of the meeting and is as follows:

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mayor and Council of the City of Idaho Falls will hold a special meeting on May 27, 1986, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock A.M., at the Conference Room in the City Hall, 308 "C" Street, in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, for the purpose of considering the adoption of an ordinance supplementing the provisions of Ordinance No. 1786 and Ordinance No. 1806 of said City with respect to certain working capital requirements of the electric system of said City.

The City Attorney advised the Council that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the adoption of an ordinance supplementing the provisions of Ordinance No. 1786 and Ordinance No. 1806 of the City, relating to the working capital requirement with respect to the funds of the Electric Light Division of the City contained in said ordinances.

Ordinance No. 1830 was thereupon introduced in written form by the City Attorney and was read by title. Councilman Chandler moved, and Councilman Hovey seconded, that the rule requiring the reading of the ordinance three different days and once in full be dispensed with and the motion was adopted by the vote of not less than one-half plus one of the members of the full Council, to-wit: Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Arthur R. Chandler, Jr., Wesley W. Deist, Melvin Erickson, Paul Hovey, Sam Sakaguchi, and Ralph Wood; No, none; carried.

Thereupon, pursuant to motion made by Councilman Chandler, and seconded by Councilman Hovey, Ordinance No. 1830 was adopted by the following vote: Ayes, Councilmen Arthur R. Chandler, Jr., Wesley W. Deist, Melvin L. Erickson, Paul Hovey, Sam Sakaguchi, and Ralph Wood; No, none; carried.

Ordinance No. 1830 was thereupon signed by the Mayor in evidence of his approval, was attested by the City Clerk, and was recorded, caption of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1786  
AND ORDINANCE NO. 1806, ESTABLISHING THE  
AMOUNT OF WORKING CAPITAL REASONABLY  
REQUIRED FOR EFFICIENT OPERATION AND

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MAINTENANCE OF THE ELECTRIC SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AS AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO FOUR MONTHS' AVERAGE OF OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE EXPENSES FOR THE LAST PRECEDING YEAR.
