

MARCH 3, 1986

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Planning Center, 308 "C" Street on March 3, 1986, at 4:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering the passage of an ordinance which would provide for the purchase of property from School District #91.

There were present at said meeting: Mayor Tom Campbell; Councilmen Arthur Chandler, Wesley Deist, Melvin Erickson, Paul Hovey and Ralph Wood. Absent: Councilman Sam Sakaguchi. Also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Craig Lords, Municipal Services Director; Dale Storer, City Attorney.

At the request of Mayor Campbell, Attorney Storer explained the need for passage of an ordinance when there is an exchange of property. He said the proposed ordinance would set a date for a public hearing and declare the intent of the exchange. Attorney Storer then read the following:

ORDINANCE NO. 1818-A

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN INTENTION TO EXCHANGE CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 91; DESCRIBING EACH OF THE PROPERTIES TO BE EXCHANGED; SETTING A DATE AND TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE DEEDS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH SUCH EXCHANGE; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

The foregoing ordinance was presented in title. It was moved by Councilman Deist, seconded by Erickson, that the provisions of Section 50-902 of the Idaho Code requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with, the question being, "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-902 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Wood, Chandler, Erickson, Deist, and Hovey; No, none; carried. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration, the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Wood, Chandler, Erickson, Deist, and Hovey; No, none; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Erickson, seconded by Deist, that the meeting adjourn at 4:10 P.M., carried.
