

NOVEMBER 26, 1985

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, met in Special Session in the Mayor's conference room at City Hall, 308 C Street on November 26, 1985, at 12:00 Noon, for the purpose of considering an ordinance for snow removal.

There were present at said meeting: Mayor Tom Campbell; Councilmen Art Chandler, Wes Deist, Melvin Erickson, Paul Hovey, and Sam Sakaguchi; Absent, Councilman Ralph Wood. Also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Dale Storer, City Attorney; Chad Stanger, Public Works Director.

The following ordinance was presented by the City Attorney:

ORDINANCE NO. 1809

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN ORDER TO FACILITATE SNOW REMOVAL WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; DEFINING CERTAIN TERMS; PROHIBITING PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES, MOTORCYCLES AND TRAILERS, ON DESIGNATED STREETS DURING SPECIFIED TIMES, AND PROVIDING FOR REMOVAL OF VEHICLES VIOLATING THIS ORDINANCE; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The foregoing ordinance was presented in title. It was moved by Councilman Chandler, seconded by Sakaguchi, that the provisions of Section 50-902 of the Idaho Code requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being "SHALL THE PROVISION OF SECTION 50-902 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Deist, Hovey, Sakaguchi, Chandler, and Erickson; No, none; carried. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration, the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Deist, Hovey, Sakaguchi, Chandler, and Erickson; No, none; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Chandler, seconded by Deist, that the meeting adjourn at 1:00 P.M., carried.
