

AUGUST 16, 1983

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Council Chamber on August 16, 1983, at 7:00 P.M., for the purpose of conducting a public hearing to provide public participation in the formulation of the proposed General Revenue Sharing Budget. There were present at said meeting: Mayor Tom Campbell; Councilmen Ralph Wood, Art Chandler, Mel Erickson, Paul Hovey, and Sam Sakaguchi. Absent: Councilman Wes Deist. Also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Dale Storer, City Attorney and all other available Division Directors.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and the place, as legally advertised, to conduct a public hearing to provide for public participation in the formulation of the proposed General Revenue Sharing Budget, as follows:

It was then moved by Councilman Chandler, seconded by Erickson, that the General Revenue Sharing expenditures be adopted as proposed. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Wood, Chandler, Erickson, Hovey, and Sakaguchi; No, none; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Wood, seconded by Hovey, that the meeting adjourn at 7:05 P.M., carried.
