

AUGUST 26, 1981

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Council Chamber on August 26, 1981 at 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of conducting a public hearing to provide public participation in the formulation of the proposed General Revenue Sharing Budget. There were present at said meeting: Mayor Tom Campbell; Councilmen Wes Deist, Paul Hovey, Sam Sakaguchi, Ralph Wood, and Art Chandler. Absent: Councilman Mel Erickson, as he was out of town on City business. Also present: Velma Chandler, City Clerk; Dale Storer, Assistant City Attorney; and, all other available Division Directors.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and the place, as legally advertised, to conduct a public hearing to provide for public participation in the formulation of the proposed General Revenue Sharing Budget, as follows:

PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is Hereby given that a special public hearing will be conducted by the City Council of Idaho Falls, Idaho on August 26, 1981 at 7:00 p.m. of said day in the Council Chambers of the Electric Building at 140 South Capital Avenue in said City to provide public participation in the formulation of the 1981-1982 Fiscal Year GENERAL REVENUE SHARING BUDGET.

At said hearing, all interested persons will be afforded the opportunity to provide written and oral comments on the possible uses of said entitlement funds.

It has been proposed that said budget shall be as follows:

Fire Station No. 4 - Lease Purchase	48,600.00
Auditorium - Heating Plant	28,000.00
Public Safety	233,200.00

	<u>\$540,000.00</u>

Councilman Hovey, Chairman of the Finance Committee, explained the purpose of the Revenue Sharing Hearing. He pointed out that the Revenue Sharing Budget is just as the notice indicated and not an expenditure budget. It was moved by Councilman Hovey, seconded by Chandler, that the General Revenue Sharing Funds, as appropriated and outlined in the amount of \$540,000.00 be accepted and approved by the Council. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 5; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Wood, seconded by Hovey, that the meeting adjourn at 7:05 p.m.; carried.
