Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on the 4th day of May, 1978 at 5:00 P.M. for the purpose of retiring into executive session to consider salary adjustments for non-union electrical employees. Barnes, City Clerk, Arthur Smith, City Attorney.

It was moved by Councilman Wood, seconded by Hovey, that the Mayor and all Councilmen retire into executive session to consider salary adjustments for non-union electrical employees. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 6; No, none; carried.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Erickson, that this meeting adjourn at 5:30 P.M., carried.
