

SEPTEMBER 1, 1977

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Council Chambers in Idaho Falls, Idaho, on Thursday, the 1st day of September, 1997 at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of conducting a public hearing to provide public participation in the formulation of the General Revenue Sharing Fund Budget; also, conducting a public hearing to provide public participation in the formulation of the Anti-Recession Fiscal Assistance Fund Budget; also, to consider any other business which might be appropriately presented. There were present at said meeting: Mayor S. Eddie Pedersen; Councilmen Gil Karst, Paul Hovey, Tom Campbell, Jim Freeman, and Ralph Wood. Absent: Councilman Mel Erickson. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; and John Evans, City Controller.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and the place, as advertised, to conduct a public hearing, to provide public transportation in the formulation of the proposed General Revenue Sharing Fund Budget, as follows:
