

NOVEMBER 15, 1977

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, of the City of Idaho Falls met in special session in the Mayor's Chambers at City Hall on November 15th, 1977, at 5:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering a contract between the City and the Bonneville Fire District No. 1. There were present at said meeting: Mayor S. Eddie Pedersen, Councilmen Tom Campbell, Jim Freeman, Mel Erickson, Ralph Wood, and Gil Karst. Absent: Councilman Paul Hovey. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk.

Councilman Freeman introduced a contract between the City and the Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1, stating terms and conditions for the occupancy, use, furniture, equipment and maintenance of the new fire station facility as well as costs pertaining thereto. It was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Wood, that this contract be approved and the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 5; No, none; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Karst, seconded by Freeman, that the meeting adjourn at 5:15 P.M., carried.
