
The receipt of general public comment today is not a public hearing nor is it intended to replace the public hearing required under Idaho Code § 67-8206.

The public comment period for this meeting is limited to thirty (30) minutes of in-person presentation on a first come, first served basis. When you address the Committee, please state your name. Please limit your remarks to approximately five (5) minutes. If you are not able to present during this period, please remember that the members of the committee, and other public officials, may be contacted through mail, email, telephone, through the City's website, or other means. In addition, the City shall hold a public hearing, as required by Idaho Code § 67-8206, at a later date. The date and time for that hearing has not been set yet but will be noticed at least fifteen (15) days prior to the hearing following the required notice requirements in Idaho Code § 67-8206(3).
