

NOTICE

The state-wide stay at home order issued by the Governor's office in order to fight the community spread of the Coronavirus in the state of Idaho has been confirmed. The Governor's list of essential services has been released and identifies essential infrastructure, including residential and commercial construction listed as essential.

With this ruling the building department will continue to conduct building inspections. When scheduling inspections the following is required:

- 1. For inspections that are to take place in occupied homes and businesses please provide a contact number for the occupants that the inspector can call prior to performing the inspection.
- 2. For inspections that are to take place on new construction jobsites please inform all workers to maintain the distances from the inspectors as mandated by the Idaho Division of Public Health and the CDC.
- 3. Depending on the type of inspection a video or photos of the work may be taken that can be e-mailed to the inspector for review. This will depend on the scope of work and will require prior approval by the inspector if this method may be used.

The city annex is closed to the public which will now require all business to be transmitted by telephone, e-mail or the use of the e-Trakit Permitting System. Permit applications and plans for review are to also be submitted electronically.

We appreciate your cooperation in regard to the state-wide stay at home order as the City of Idaho Falls will make every effort to provide the essential services needed while keeping our citizens safe.
