**CALLS FOR SERVICE/INCIDENTS**

***Notable CFS/Incidents***

- 4/25/21      2021-14944    DUI Vehicle Collision  
On April 25, at approximately 2:30 a.m., Idaho Falls Police Officers responded to the area of Constitution and Yellowstone Hwy for a report that a vehicle had struck a brick wall in a parking lot. Officers arrived and upon investigation determined that the driver was DUI. The driver consented to a breathalyzer and gave samples of .192 and .194, and was cited for misdemeanor DUI.
- 4/25/21      2021-15019    DUI Vehicle Collision  
On April 25, at approximately 11:00 p.m., Idaho Falls Police Officers responded to a report of a vehicle collision near Lee Street and 14<sup>th</sup> Street. When Officers arrived, they determined that an unknown vehicle had been traveling at a high rate of speed eastbound on 14<sup>th</sup> Street (which is a one way westbound street) when it had struck two parked vehicles, pushing one into a street sign knocking it down, and causing significant damage to both vehicles. The suspect vehicle had fled the scene, but had clearly sustained damage based on a tire and rim that had come off the vehicle along with other debris that were left on scene. Additional Officers searched the surrounding area and located the suspect vehicle in the alleyway near Higbee Street and 16<sup>th</sup> Street. A man who admitted to driving the vehicle was located next to it, and was found to be obviously intoxicated. The man consented to performing Field Sobriety Tests, and gave breathalyzer samples of .212 and .215. The man was cited for Misdemeanor Hit & Run and Misdemeanor DUI (Excessive).
- 4/30/21      2021-15692    Indecent Exposure – Psychiatric Problem  
On April 30, shortly after 10:00 a.m., Idaho Falls Police Officers were dispatched to the area of Ryder Park, 2001 W Sunnyside Road, for a report of a man exposing himself to people at the park. Officers arrived and located the man. The man appeared to be quite agitated and was making loud non-sensical statements, while also being uncooperative with Officers and stating that he was allowed to expose his genitals. Officers identified that the man appeared to be experiencing some kind of psychiatric issue and detained him both for his safety, and to investigate the criminal issue.  
Officers spoke with multiple victims whom the male had exposed his genitals too, including a parent who had children present when the incident occurred.  
The man was cited for Indecent Exposure. Due to the apparent psychiatric issue the man was experiencing he was transported to Eastern Idaho Regional Medical Center for evaluation.

- 5/1/2021 2021-15912 Disturbance  
Shortly before 4:00 p.m., Idaho Falls Police Officers responded to the Leo’s parking lot at 155 S. Holmes Ave for a report of a physical disturbance in progress involving a large group of people. Officers responded and deescalated the argument in progress which appeared to have began as a verbal argument before turning physical. Officers spoke with multiple involved parties who each had different accounts of the incident. No serious injuries were reported from anyone involved and no arrests have been made at this time.
