## CALLS FOR SERVICE/INCIDENTS

### *Notable CFS/Incidents*

- 6/14/21 2021-22017 Missing Juvenile  
Officers conducted and search for and located a missing endangered juvenile. The search lasted approximately three and a half hours with over a dozen officers and Bonneville County Deputies assisting in the search. The juvenile was found safe.
- 6/14/21 2021-21893 Prowler  
Investigated reports of a prowler and apprehending Haven Torres. See prior release for details.
- 6/15/21 2021-22157 Welfare Check – Lemonade Stand  
At approximately 4:00 p.m., Idaho Falls Police Dispatch received a call from a person who was concerned about the placement of a lemonade stand and the safety of the children operating the stand. Children had set up the lemonade stand in a grassy median and the driver was concerned the children may get hit by a car.  
Officers responded and found that the children were indeed set up on a grassy median in the middle of the roadway. The children had begun to pack up their stand prior to when officers arrived. Officers enjoyed cups of strawberry lemonade they purchased from the young entrepreneurs, then helped the kids pack up their stand and safely cross traffic to head home.
- 6/15/21 2021-22204 Suspicious  
Shortly before midnight, Idaho Falls Police Dispatch received a call regarding a man holding a pistol in his hand and walking in the roadway. Officers responded and made contact with the male who complied with officers when directed to drop the object in his hands. The object was determined to be a flashlight and officers determined that no crime had been committed. The man continued on his way.
- 6/16/21 2021-22214 Vehicle Collision – Intoxicated Juvenile  
Idaho Falls Police Officers responded to a report of a vehicle collision in the 1300 block of John Adams Parkway. A juvenile had been driving a vehicle along John Adams when they struck a parked vehicle, pushing that vehicle into a second parked vehicle and causing significant damage to all three vehicles. Two residential trash bins were also struck in the process leaving trash and debris along the roadway.  
Officers determined that the juvenile may be under the influence and conducted field sobriety tests on the juvenile and administered a breathalyzer test. The juvenile blew breath samples of .195 and .197 blood alcohol content (BAC). It is illegal in Idaho for legal adults to drive with a BAC of .08 or more and BAC of .2 or higher is considered an “Excessive DUI.”

Officers conducted a search of the vehicle and found an open container of Twisted Tea, and .75 grams of Marijuana.

The juvenile was referred to Juvenile Court to address the incident.

- 6/16/21 2021-22346 Fire – Assist  
Assisted Idaho Falls Fire with response to structure fire on Johnson Street.
- 6/16/21 2021-22377 Intoxicated Female  
At approximately 11:20 p.m., Idaho Falls Police and Idaho Falls Fire responded to the area of 1000 Memorial Drive for a report of a woman pulled from the Snake River. From speaking to witnesses, Officers were able to determine that a group of people were walking along the Greenbelt when they heard a woman calling for help. The group located the woman, who was reportedly partially in the water near the river’s edge and were able to pull the woman from the river before calling first responders for assistance. The woman was highly intoxicated and appears to have entered the river of her own accord, but fortunately did not sustain any serious injuries from the incident.
- 6/17/21 2021-22391 Fire – Assist  
Assisted Idaho Falls Fire with response to structure fire on Highland Drive.
- 6/17/21 2021-22451 Vehicle Versus Pedestrian  
At approximately 11:40 a.m., Officers responded to a vehicle versus pedestrian collision near the intersection of W Broadway Ave and Shoupe Avenue. According to witnesses and video footage of the incident a vehicle was turning from Shoupe onto Broadway when the vehicle struck a pedestrian attempting to cross the road. The pedestrian’s injuries were non-life threatening. The circumstances of the collision are under investigation.
- 6/17/21 2021-22520 Psychiatric Issue  
Officers responded to Walmart for a report of a possibly intoxicated male. Officers were able to determine that the adult male was not intoxicated but autistic and agitated. Officers were able to contact a family member who responded to assist the man.
