REGISTRATION INFORMATION

1. This is Team Registration only. Individuals must find a team or be placed on our waiting list.
2. Resident vs. Non-Resident will be determined by a players verified address. To register as a Resident please follow the instructions on Page #2!
3. Non-Resident players will still pay the Non-Resident fee even if they are a part of a majority IF Resident team.
4. **The enclosed roster must be used. Please fill this out completely!**
5. Persons interested in becoming a head coach in the League shall complete a background check that is paid for by Parks and Rec. The background check must be completed before games start.
6. The Parks and Recreation reserves the right to add additional players to your team.
7. Coaches please collect all fees and bring them in with the roster and waivers at the same time. **Do not instruct your children to bring their payments in separately.**
8. Tax and jersey cost is included in the player fee.
9. A receipt will be provided for the number of players who pay their fees. This receipt will entitle you to the same number of jerseys for your team.
10. Make checks payable to: City of Idaho Falls
11. If you are in need of additional players, call 208-612-8580. We have a waiting list of kids who don't have a team.
12. Individuals who register after the deadline with the coach's approval will be charged a \$10 late fee.

Junior High Basketball Regulations

1. Eight (8) minute quarters. Clock stops on foul shots and last minute of 2nd and 4th quarters. The clock will run in 4th quarter if a team is 15 points ahead.
2. Teams are allowed two (2) time outs per half.
3. Any defense can be used.
4. Games need to begin on time. Please do not be late. When late, game clock will be set and started. Teams will play remaining available time.
5. Four (4) players needed to begin the game. Both teams must play 4 players.
6. A regulation 28.5 basketball will be used for girls and a 29.5 for boys.
7. The clock will run in 4th quarter if a team is 15 points ahead.
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Any player, coaches or spectator that uses profane language, gestures or unacceptable behavior will be kicked out of the building at the referees judgement in addition to any technical fouls received.
9. One, three (3) minute overtime period will be played once if time permits.
10. Other than the above rules, high school rules will be used.
