Latex Paint Disposal

Let the paint solidify by leaving the can open for a period of time. Once the paint has solidified, dispose of it in the household trash. To help in solidifying the paint, you can mix it with sand or kitty litter.

Unused or expired prescription drugs can be disposed of inside the Idaho Falls Police Department main entrance, located at 605 N. Capital, in the green box marked "Pharmaceutical Disposal Only," year-round between 8am-5pm, Mon-Fri. No syringes accepted.
