

ICUA YOUTH RALLY RULES OF CONDUCT

1. All participants will follow the rules, regulations and schedules governing the rally. Failure to do so could result in the participant being sent home at his/her parent's expense.
2. Any use of alcohol or illegal drugs during the rally will result in the participant being sent home at his/her parent's expense.
3. Sexual misconduct will not be tolerated and will result in the participant being sent home at his/her parent's expense.
4. All persons and property will be treated with respect at all times. Any person destroying or taking property that does not belong to them will be charged for the cost of the damage and may be turned over to the appropriate authority.
5. Abusive language will not be tolerated.
6. Water fights will not be allowed in the dorms.
7. Fireworks or water balloons will not be allowed.
8. Participants driving their own vehicles to the rally will deposit their vehicle keys with the rally chairman for the duration of the rally. Participants will not be permitted to drive their vehicle for any reason during the time of the rally.
9. Dress for classes will be similar to that worn to attend high school classes. Shoes and shirts are required. Shorts are permitted however, they must be deemed "appropriate" by the committee.
10. Food will not be ordered for delivery to the dorm after 10:00 p.m.
11. Participants will not be allowed to leave the campus without being accompanied by a chaperone.
12. Curfew is 11:00 p. m. each night unless otherwise determined by the schedule. Participants will be in their assigned rooms at this time.
