LATEX PAINT DISPOSAL

Let the paint solidify by leaving the can open for a period of time. Once the paint has solidified, dispose of it in the household trash. To help in solidifying the paint, you can mix it with sand or kitty litter.

UNUSED OR EXPIRED PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

Unused or expired prescription drugs can be disposed of inside the Idaho Falls Police Department main entrance, located at 605 N. Capital, in the container marked "Unused Rx Pills," between 8am-5pm, Mon-Fri.

BONNEVILLE COUNTY HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) PROGRAM

Bonneville County has a separate program designed specifically for the disposal of items not appropriate to dispose of at home or in the dumpsters listed on the front page of this flyer. Please help keep our community safe by properly disposing of HHW. Careless use and disposal of these substances contaminate our food, soil, water and air, and seriously threaten the health of plants, animals and people. **Collection is the 2nd Saturday of each month, May-September, 9am-3pm at the Bonneville County Transfer Station.** (May 10th, June 14th, July 12th, Aug. 9th, Sept. 13th). www.co.bonneville.id.us
